ABOUT MCCS

Monroe County Christian School was born from prayer meetings in early 2017, when a group of community members recognized the need for an evangelical Christian school in Monroe County. MCCS began its first school year on August 22, 2018 with just 9 students, 3 grades, and 2 teachers who shared a vision for Christcentered education.

What started as a step of faith has grown into a thriving, mission-driven school bearing lasting fruit for God's kingdom. We provide an excellent Christian education at an economical cost—under \$7,200 per child—with an annual tuition of just \$4,500, the lowest for private education in the St. Louis area.

Now, with enrollment rising rapidly (31% yearly average), MCCS is outgrowing its current facility—making expansion not just a goal, but a vital next step in our mission.

We aim to raise \$20 Million to fund construction of a new K–12 facility and launch a \$1 million endowment to ensure MCCS remains strong, affordable, and Christ-centered for years to come.

This \$20 Million campaign is about more than expanding a campus. Each step moves us closer to a space where students can grow in both faith and knowledge for generations to come.

Steps We've Taken Towards our Goals

 Secured 21 acres on the north side of Waterloo—an ideal location easily accessible from Route 3 and situated along the major north—south corridor of Rogers Street.

Planned out a 40,605 square foot purpose-built K-12 facility consisting of 22 classrooms which include an art room, a science lab, a band room, a discovery room, a library, a cafeteria, breakout rooms, a multi-purpose gym & stage area, and 5 office spaces.

 Assembled a trusted team of architects, engineers, marketing professionals, and community leaders to help bring this vision to life.
